

**GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS**

To graduate from a University Prep Schools high school, each student must:

1. Complete at least eight (8) semesters of high school. To be issued a diploma, the academic transcript must show successful completion of the following:

2. Develop, annually review, and successfully carry out an individual Educational Development Plan (EDP) as facilitated via your college counselor and/or Crew Leader. The product of which includes but is not limited to the following **College & Career Readiness Standards\*\*\*\***:
  - a. (2) Career Pathways identified in Naviance
  - b. (100) Community Service / Volunteer Hours
  - c. (3) College Acceptances\*\*\*\*\*
  - d. Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
3. Receive academic credit (as measured by mastery of specific content expectations for each course) for programs of instruction as specified below. Courses in which students receive a failing (F) or incomplete (I) grade do not count toward graduation credit although they are counted against the overall cumulative grade point average.

\*Courses in **RED** must be taken and passed as titled

\*\*Upon successful completion of courses in sequence, a 3<sup>rd</sup>/4<sup>th</sup> year of this curricular area is required.

\*\*\*The first year of foreign language will be considered if earned in grade 8. Proficiency testing required.

\*\*\*\*The College & Career Ready diploma endorsement is awarded to students who successfully meet these standards.

\*\*\*\*\* **COLLEGE** is defined as any postsecondary learning institutions including: 4-year, 2-year, technical, trade, and military options.
